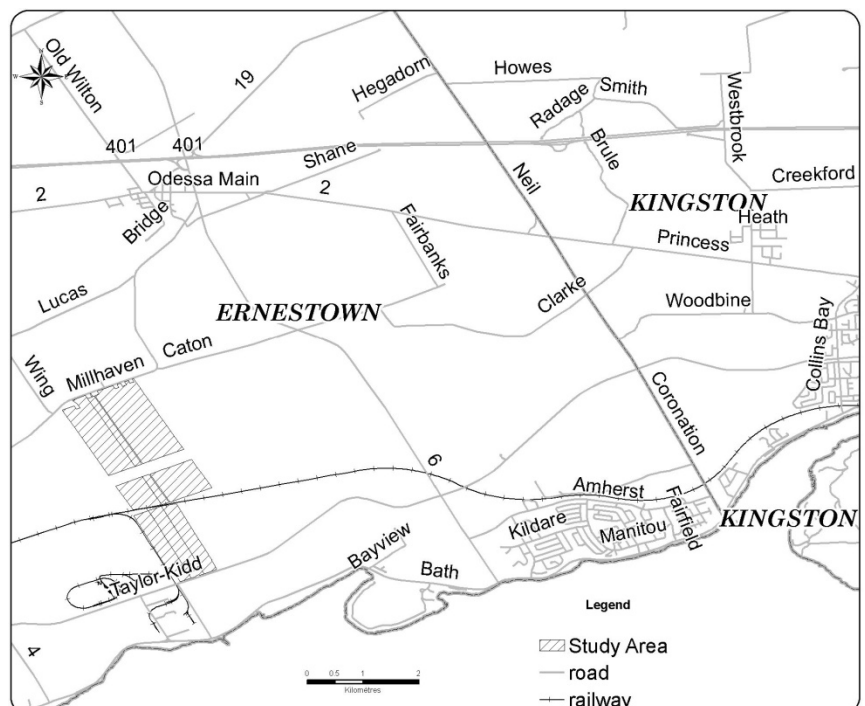

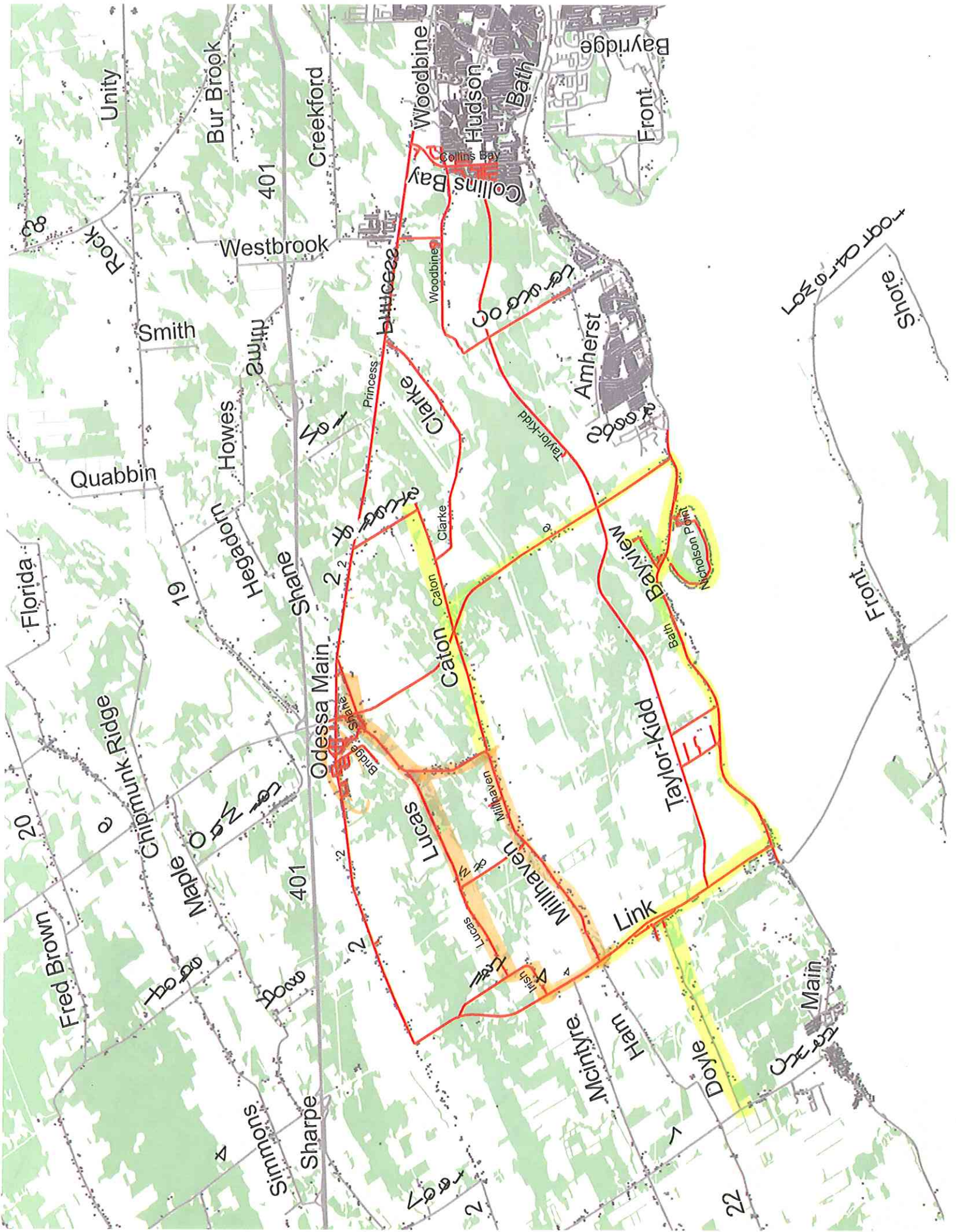

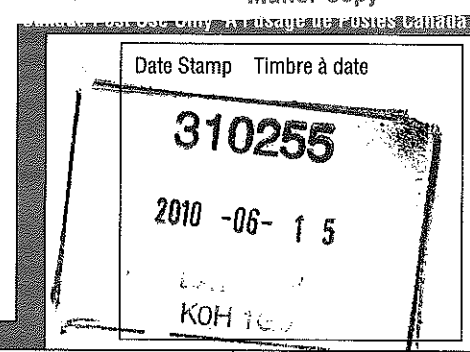

To Whom It May Concern,


I am writing to express my support for the 10MW Ernestown wind development. Wind energy is a very important resource that we cannot afford to ignore in Eastern Ontario. I believe that in most cases, the Ontario Green Energy Act gives adequate protection to landowners near the turbines and I am in favour of this particular development, as it is near to distribution lines and on land that is mostly vacant.

Every form of energy production has some impact on the environment and the nearby residents, and so do many other features of modern society like highways, railways, and airports. Wind turbines are no different – except that they can be built quickly, have a very small footprint on the land, and leave no toxic residue at the end of their life.

It's not just a choice of 'wind turbines' or 'no wind turbines'. We need to measure the value and impact of wind turbine developments by comparing them to the alternatives – and the alternatives in my view are generally worse. 10 MW, while small by wind park standards, is still worth doing, especially since all the financial risks are borne by the private developers who have the courage to play in this new Ontario industry.

While I am writing today on St Lawrence College letterhead, please remember that my views are my own and do not represent any official college position. It should be noted however that the college does have excellent programs in wind and renewable energy technologies and continues to make investments to provide world class training in these areas.

As an Institute within Queen's University, we neither endorse nor criticize proposed developments that we have not studied. However, we can certainly contribute observations relevant to a decision about development of the Ernestown Wind Park.

First, the proposed project, being much smaller than the existing Trans-Alta facility on Wolfe Island, offers the possibility of interesting lessons about the proper scale for wind development in populated rural areas of Ontario.

Second, Southeastern Ontario is rich in renewable energy resources — wind, sun, hydro and both agricultural and forest biomass. The region is therefore an excellent test case for the thoughtful development of networked renewable energy supply; the sort of system that some researchers believe can provide even base-load electricity reliably. The proposed project could be a valuable element of that regional renewable energy portfolio.

Third, Kingston, Frontenac, Lennox and Addington are committed to developing the expertise and the investment climate that will support new forms of energy, and they hope to see social and economic benefits from those developments. Research and training going on at both Queen's University and St. Lawrence College provides support to those plans and are premised on continued growth in new forms of energy generation and use.

If the Ernestown Wind Park Development is approved, the Queen's Institute for Energy and Environmental Policy very much looks forward to opportunities to work with the proponents to track its success, to assess and understand its impact, and to learn any lessons that its progress has to offer about how best to achieve the public good.

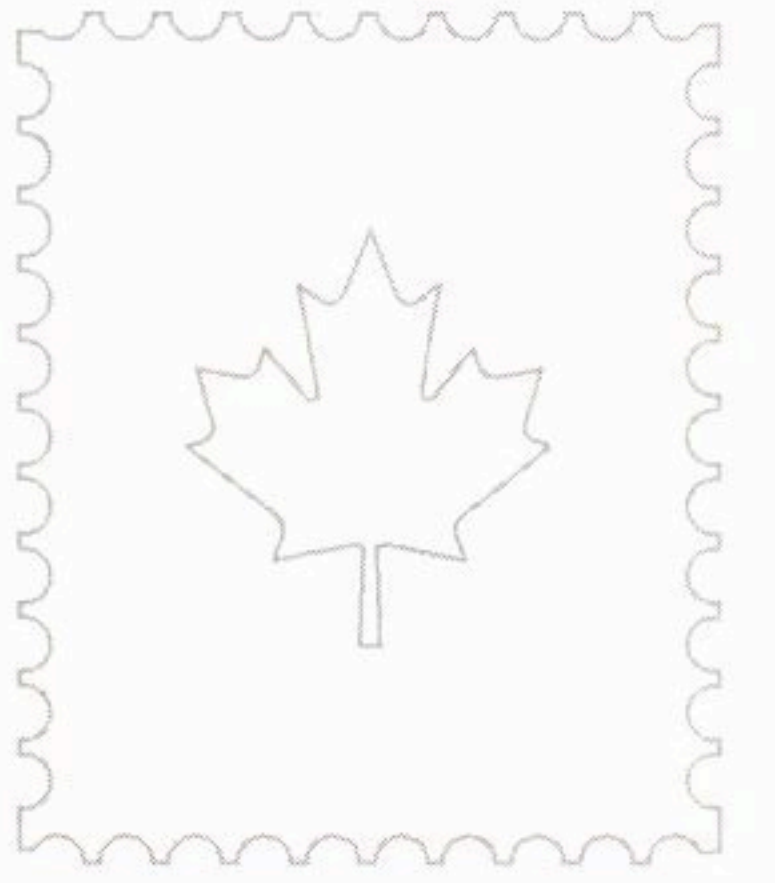
